



SATION 86 Touch Screen Background Image Changing

- 1: Prepare a png format picture with a resolution of 720*720 pixels:
- 2: Use the tool BmpCvt.exe to convert the png format image into a dta format file. Open the tool BmpCvt.exe, click file->Open to open the PNG image in step 1, and then click file->Save As... The saving type is "C" stream (*.dta) file, as shown below:



After clicking Save, select "true color with alpha" (default option) in the color options window that appears, as shown in the figure below



- 3: Rename the converted dta format file to bg_home.dta. The file name is the background image file name. The name is fixed and cannot be changed, otherwise it cannot be upgraded, as shown on the right:

Change the picture upgrade package path to Sation->Pictures
The bg_home.dta file is replaced with the newly converted bg_home.dta file,

Icons and background images can be upgraded and updated through a USB flash drive. The specific steps are as follows:

- 3.1: Use a USB flash drive with the file system FAT32;
- 3.2: Create a new directory as shown below (contact the manufacturer directly to obtain the upgrade package):
- 3.3: First disconnect the auxiliary power of the touch screen, and then insert the USB flash drive with the upgrade file package;
- 3.4: After the touch screen enters the main interface, click the settings icon in the upper left corner;
- 3.5: Find the update picture function (the second to last item), first check the right box to activate it, and then click to update the picture;
- 3.6: After entering the update picture interface, click the "Update" button to update the picture;
- 3.7: Click the "Stop" button to stop the update, click the "Exit" button to return to the previous level;
- 3.8: After updating the image, you need to power off and restart to refresh again.

4: During the image update process, view the file name page bg_home.dta. After the background image is completely updated, you can click the Stop button to exit the update, as shown in the figure below.



After exiting, power off and restart. The background image update is completed.
